MPs bring Brexit debate to Carshalton Boys

Last Friday our two local Sutton MPs came into school to debate Britain's membership of the European Union. With just over one month to go until the EU referendum takes place they went head-to-head to thrash out the pros and cons of Brexit. Tom Brake, Liberal Democrat MP for Carshalton and Wallington, made the case for Britain remaining in the EU, while Paul Scully, Conservative MP for Sutton and Cheam, argued the benefits of Britain leaving the EU. The MPs fielded a range of questions from students including the possible consequences of Brexit on business and trade, how decision making works within the EU, the impact of the freedom of movement of people and the nature of the campaign so far. While the MPs disagreed on the possible effects of Brexit they did agree it was important for young people to ensure their voice is heard by participating in the referendum. Many students commented on how much they learned from the debate with some stating it has inspired them to actually turn out to vote on June 23rd.
