Tuesday we took a team of 10 year 8 gifted DT students to The Royal Alexander and Albert School for the Construction challenge.

After a short talk from a structural engineer they were given the brief to build a bridge to span a 1.5m ravine. This was to be made from rolled up A4 paper held with nuts and bolts.

Costs had to be calculated in order to decide which bridge made the greatest profit after testing. Winning bridge supported 3.5kg at the centre
