Years 7-9 Internal Exams

As you are aware, your son will shortly be sitting end of year exams for English, Maths and Science. These were originally scheduled for the week commencing Monday 26th June however, in order to accommodate the number of public exams and due to the availability of the sports hall, it has been necessary to make a slight adjustment to these dates and the exams will now be taking place on Wednesday 21st, Thursday 22nd and Friday 23rd June.

Uniform for September 2017

If, during the summer break, you find that your son has outgrown/lost etc items of uniform required for September 2017, new items can be purchased in the following ways:

1. Make an appointment

Monday 24th July to Friday 1st September - an appointment system will operate. Please either email <u>uniform@carshaltonboys.org</u> or telephone 020 8714 3100 to **book your 15 minute appointment**.

You must make an appointment prior to coming to school to purchase uniform. As you will appreciate it is a very busy time of year for us and in order to cope with the high volume of uniform orders an appointment system will avoid long queues and delays for parents. Payment can be made by card only. OR

2. Order via WisePay

Place your order on WisePay. Orders will be available for collection after 2 working days, during the above period (Monday 24th July – Friday 1st September) from 9:00am – 2:30pm.

No sales will be able to be made off the street. Also please note that due to the end of our Financial Year process that the school shop will be closed on Monday 5 September for one week. All items of uniform must be purchased and collected in advance of this date.

Cashless School

Please note that it is our plan to become a 'cashless' school. Our online payments system was introduced some years ago and has proved very successful. With the introduction of the new £1 coin we are unable to update our existing revaluer machine (used by student to top up their food accounts) to accept the new coinage. As you will know student food accounts and payments for all trips, books etc can be made via WisePay (which can be accessed via the Quick Links at the top of our website, www.carshaltonboys.org). Match Report

Carshalton Titans' were narrowly beaten by NEM Hawks in another intense cup final that went to extra time for the second year running. What has been quoted as the best cup final on the day, it truly was a nail-biting encounter.

Both teams started strong with Jake Hutchison getting the first goal for the Titans' and the centre Josh McDaid scoring the majority of Hawks goals. Throughout the first half both teams would swap the lead on several occasions but due to a number of 2 minute suspensions Carshalton began to lose their way. Hawks took the game into half time with a narrow 15-14 lead after having a much bigger lead at some points in the first half. Goal scorers for Titans included Jake Hutchison, Josh Wyatt and Liam McCarthy to name a few.

Having had the chance to analyse the first period, coach Mark Hawkins passed on the vital bits of information required. Titans took this momentum into the second half, gradually building up and taking the lead. Some outstanding goalkeeping from Nicky Dhanjal as well as great defensive work from Dan Buguks, Calum O'Neill and Tyler Gilborn kept Carshalton in the lead. The addition of Derry Asante as a point defender and fresh legs from Rob Damianou and Grant Viljoen allowed Carshalton to build for the final few minutes.

The Carshalton lead lasted until the dying moments of the game and then Hawks managed to equalise with a last gasp attempt after a couple of unfortunate 2 minute suspensions for the Titans'.

Extra time started and Hawks were able to carry their clinical shooting with them, finishing the game off in the 2x5 minute halves. The game ended 31-27.

A notable performance from Titans' keeper Nicky Dhanjal, keeping Hawks out on numerous occasions and keeping titans in it. Liam McCarthy also performed well, winning man of the match. As well as the young players from Carshalton Titans', Rob Damianou, Grant Viljoen, Dan Buguks and Derry Asante all stepping up and performing when it mattered.
