An appointment must be made to collect uniform that you have ordered online via WisePay. Appointments are available at the following times:

Monday 20th June until Thursday 14th July - 2.45pm-3.45pm

Saturday 9th July - 9am - 1pm (limited availability left)

Monday - Thursdays throughout the summer holidays between 10am-2pm.

Please note the **last appointment date is 25th August**. This is to ensure that your child has the correct uniform to start the new term in September. After this date any uniform you wish to purchase must be ordered via our on line payment system, Wise Pay. These items will be available for collection from the school shop 48 hours after purchase, between the hours of **8-8.30am in term time only**

They were up against it from the beginning playing against boroughs who had representatives from several different schools but that didn't deter the focus and concentration of the team. Drawn in a particularly tough group they set about their business beating Kingston 3-1 and Barnet 9-3. They then suffered their first defeat against Havering 5-4 but having been 4-0 down almost managed to pull it back. The boys pulled themselves together again recording comfortable victories over Newham and Lambeth to qualify for the quarter-finals. At this stage they met Bromley and put in a magnificent all round performance to win 4-0 and play eventual winners Ealing in the semi-final.
