Brief outline of what students & Parents can be doing at home to improve understanding	<p>For each event that students study, they should be able to offer, from memory, the 5Ws;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What happened, • Who was involved/affected, • Where was involved/affected, • When it occurred, • Why it occurred/was significant. <p>Parents can support their son’s learning by testing them on the events after they have studied them in class.</p> <p>Parents could also help students attempt past exam questions and online revision quizzes, which will be set for homework, every other week.</p>
