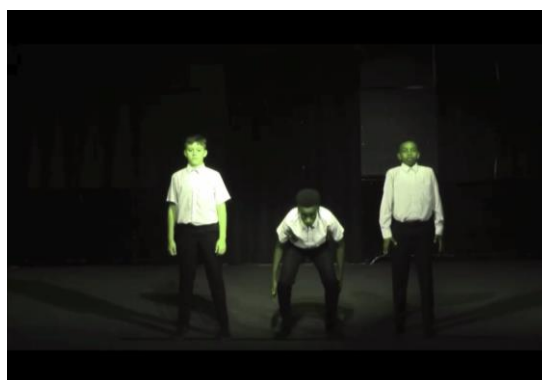
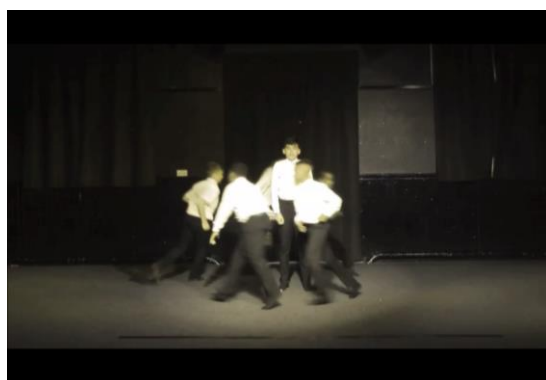

## Brooklands Museum and Mercedes-Benz World

On the 12 of December 2017, Year 9 Engineering students had the opportunity to visit Brooklands Museum and Mercedes-Benz World

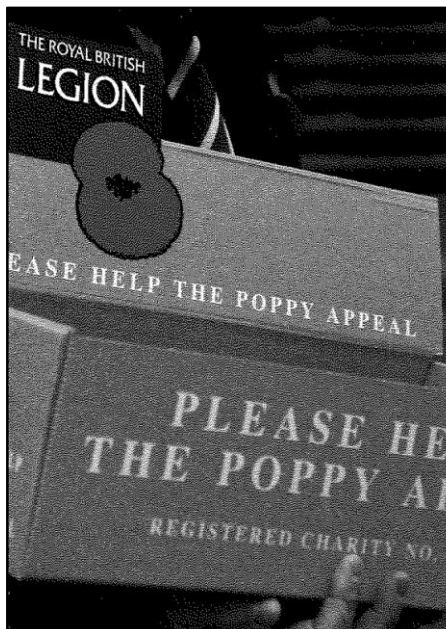
Firstly, we arrived at Brooklands Museum where we were introduced to our tour guide Lee. He had given us a detailed description of the evolution of motor vehicles. He had given us a viewing of most restored cars that would have previously been raced around Brookland race track. We had been shown the first generation of racing cars compared to the latest generation. This included F1 cars. By the end of the tour of Brooklands Racing Cars, we had been granted a chance to experience sitting in a model F1 McLaren simulator.

In Brooklands, we also looked at the collection of planes and aircrafts, also how Brooklands used to be a runway. We managed to even have a first-hand experience of going into one of the passenger aircraft called the Concorde and viewing how it looked like and how it was manufactured. Brooklands also had a workshop where you were able to see where planes were built.

After our tour of Brooklands Museum was completed, we went to Mercedes-Benz World where we were allowed to explore all of the different generations of cars in the company. We were also given the chance to sit inside a few vehicles to get a front row experience of the new cars available. The staff there were kind enough to let us watch a short movie about the history of Mercedes-Benz, where it originates from, and also how this company was successful then and even now. I thought that it was very fascinating to know how this world-known company was actually 2 different companies working to earn their own reputation. It was the work of Karl Benz and Gottlieb Daimler that have created the cars we know and love to this day.
