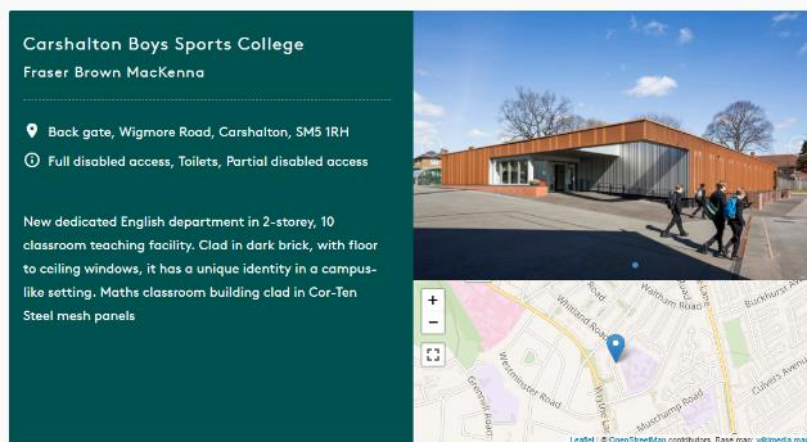




Open House London – English and Maths buildings
