

## **Sixth Form Dress Code Policy**

On a day-to-day basis, CBSC operates a smart casual dress code. There are however, occasions where students are required to wear smart business wear. This includes internal / external examinations, some trips, leadership events, some visiting speakers, and some careers events.

### **Daily Smart / Casual Dress Code Expectations**

#### **Male Students**

Acceptable smart / casual dress code includes:

Short sleeved or long sleeve collared shirts  
Smart T-shirts or polo shirts  
Smart Jumpers  
Smart trousers or smart denim (no ripped, patched, or patterned denim permitted)  
Shoes or trainers  
Smart tailored shorts in summer  
Sutton United Kit for Academy students (Full kit required)

Male students are not allowed to wear:

Tracksuit bottoms (unless this is a FULL Sutton United Kit)  
Clothing with inappropriate wording or logo's  
Ripped jeans, patched or patterned denim jeans  
Baseball caps, hats or headwear (inside school or lessons)  
Team sports top e.g. rugby or football  
Sports shorts, board or jersey shorts

#### **Female Students**

Smart / Casual Dress code includes:

Smart tops with sleeves, which provide full coverage of midriff, tops should be modest. No underwear should be visible.

Smart skirts that are mid-thigh length as a minimum.

Smart dresses that are mid-thigh length as a minimum.

Smart shorts that are mid-thigh length as a minimum.

Smart Denim (no ripped, patched or patterned denim)

Female students are not allowed to wear:

Vest tops  
Tracksuit bottoms  
Clothing with inappropriate wording or logo's  
Baseball caps, hats or headwear (inside school or lessons)

Team sports top e.g. rugby or football  
Sports shorts, board or jersey shorts

### **Jewellery, piercings and tattoos**

Jewellery should be conservative  
No visible facial piercings e.g lips or nose  
Tattoos are not permitted. If students have a tattoo, it would need to be fully covered at all times.

### **Business Wear Dress Code**

There are occasions where students are required to wear smart business wear. This includes internal / external examinations, some trips, leadership events, some visiting speakers, and some careers events.

### **Male Students**

Shirt and Tie (short sleeve shirts are permitted in the summer examinations)  
Smart trousers  
Smart shoes

### **Female Students**

Smart tops suitable for interview.  
Smart trousers suitable for interview.  
Smart skirts, which are mid-thigh length as a minimum.  
Smart dresses, which are mid-thigh length as a minimum.  
Smart shorts, which are mid-thigh length as a minimum.  
Smart shoes

Students are not allowed to wear:

Jeans  
Trainers or casual footwear

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
