During your summer holidays you have a huge amount of time to get out and explore taking photos. By doing this we will have a better insight into your creative perspective.

If your photos are taken on a camera which requires you to print them, then write/type the information I require separately.

NB: Use any type of camera – SLR, digital, analogue, camera phone, IPAD, polaroid or disposable camera.

If you don't have a camera of any type you will need to borrow one from a friend or family member.

Choose 1 genre:

- Nature and landscape photography
- Portraiture
- Still Life photography
- Sports photography
- Wedding photography
- Fashion photography

Take a series of images which illustrate your creativity and personal viewpoint:

- Experiment first before selecting **4 images**
- Annotate each image by explaining the following:

Why you chose that genre

Where each of the 4 final images was taken and why you chose that location

What each image is of and why you decided to photograph each subject

What perspective you took the photos from ie where you were physically standing/sitting when you took each one and why

What was the light source in each photo? Describe the direction it was coming from and how the lighting affected your image

Explain what the aim for each image was in terms of creativity and meaning
