Target Medicine Mentoring Scheme (TMMS)

TMMS is a mentoring scheme that matches Year 12 students with current UCL medical students. Delivered using a series of information, advice and guidance events alongside face-to-face and online mentoring, the programme supports students through the process of applying to medical school.

What does TMMS involve?

Successful applicants are paired with a current UCL medical student to act as their mentor for a full year. The programme comprises face-to-face mentoring sessions, regular contact with your UCL mentor using the Brightside online mentoring platform, and a series of application support events. All mentoring sessions and events take place at UCL on Wednesday evenings.

TMMS mentees will gain:

- Tailored one to one support
- BMAT and UCAT information sessions and mock exams
- Medical admissions, student finance and personal statement guidance
- Interview skills
- The chance to quiz current medical students and qualified doctors about applying to/studying medicine and working in the profession



How do I apply?

1 Make sure you're in Year 12, interested in medicine, have GCSE grades B/score 6 or above in English Language and Maths & attend a state school.

2 Read the shortlisting criteria to ensure it's the right scheme for you by visiting our website at:
