Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to welcome all of our amazing young people back to school today.

The start of a new school year is always an opportunity to make improvements so that our students are getting the best quality of education.

As a part of our annual review process we have spoken to staff, students and parents and it is clear that sometimes our existing behaviour systems/processes have lacked clarity and consistency.

It is so important that our young people understand what is expected of them, and that any sanctions are applied consistently and fairly. To this end we have produced a behaviour guide for students that sets out clearly our expectations, and also the consequences of not following these.

We understand that our young people are learning, and so we have also spent a considerable time training staff on how to model and teach these expectations, including making reasonable adjustments where appropriate. This training has been facilitated by one of the country's leading experts on SEND and inclusion, and is ongoing throughout this academic year.

Every student has been given a copy of the guide today, and we attach a copy for your reference.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Line up outside the classroom quietly Check my uniform is correct Enter the classroom calmly and greet my teacher Sit in my allocated seat, as directed Take out equipment Complete the starter activity promptly You are expected to equip yourselves before school/at tutor time using the relevant year system 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you do not have the correct equipment you will be logged for a whole school detention If you refuse to sit in your allocated seat, lesson support will be emailed, a sanction applied whole school detention /suspension If the teacher issues a yellow card for poor behaviour from a student the next incident of poor behaviour from <u>any</u> student will result in a WSD. 		
Punctual arrival required to every to lesson	If you are late to a lesson:
