## Attendance

Our CBSC Attendance Policy on the school website [HERE](#). Attendance is directly related to attainment. **A student who attends 100% of their lessons is nearly 2x more likely to pass their Maths and English GCSEs than a student who attends 90%.** School representatives in sport are role models and must have consistent attendance. **Students with inadequate attendance or behaviour, will not be able to participate in sports fixtures.**

Work shadowing involves observing a professional in their place of work to gain a better understanding of the role and their workplace.
